

# SACWA Maitland Branch Update



What do you know about PNG (Papua New Guinea)? You may say very little! CWA studies a different country each year and at our October meeting our President (Cathy Hibbard) and Secretary (Rosalie Smith) gave us some insight on PNG. This was followed by a quiz prepared by Ruth Eglington. The land of New Guinea in the West is part owned by Indonesia & PNG which was once a protectorate of Australia is now independent. The men of PNG consider they are superior to women, so the women have to do a lot of manual work e.g. bee keeping, rearing of livestock & poultry, gardening of potatoes, yams, bananas & other food crops. PNG is now a Christian country but much witchcraft is still practiced. During WW2 the Japanese tried to invade Australia by first landing in PNG to use as a steppingstone to Australia. Both sides were hampered by the many mountains, thick jungle, dangerous rivers & diseases of malaria, dengue fever & typhoid.



## A CAR CALLED BOB

A short history of Bruce Linke with Car BOB, I happened to catch up with the well respected local resident Trevor Davey in 2011 at a social gathering and we reminisced on the time that I had my first involvement with the SA Variety Bash. In the year 2000 the Variety Bash was to finish in Ardrossan and because Trevor had been involved in the Variety Bash for a few years he was asked to help organise this event as he was a local from Maitland. A meeting was held and I was asked as the President of the Ardrossan Apex Club, along with other community members to help out. At our catch up Trevor asked if I would like to be involved in the SA Variety Bash in his car – a 1968 Holden Brougham with a theme of BOB the Builder. He discussed what Variety was all about, which is raising money for children in need and I decided that this was the charity I needed to support. I started to raise funds from local businesses and people including the Maitland Rotary Club and Maitland Apex Club and helped to raise a total of \$19,879 along with 2 new recruits based in Adelaide. Trevor eventually retired from the Variety Bash in 2017 after 21 years so I bought the car, found a new team, added a hard hat to the roof rack and continued to raise funds for this worthy cause. Please note that Trevor Davey is still actively involved with Variety, helping out with motoring events and associated activities. In 2022 the poor old Brougham had to be retired as well after completing 16 Bashes so I bought a Holden Statesman that had completed 2 Bashes. We put the roof rack with hard hat on top, put new BOB the Builder stickers on the car and kept fundraising. The Variety Bash is usually held in early August from Saturday morning to the following Saturday night and can start from anywhere in South Australia and can finish anywhere – Alice Springs and Sydney included.

# A CAR CALLED BOB cont

Please note that bitumen roads are rarely driven and our cars go on tracks that scare a lot of 4 wheel drives. Bash cars have to be at least 25 years old and not a four wheel drive – one of the regular cars is a 1938 Buick!!!! When we are doing the Bash we give grants to local communities along the way which helps us to see the benefits of our fundraising. In 2022 on my 10th Variety Bash I had the honour of presenting a cheque for \$34,500 to the Innamincka Community for the building of a playground for the locals (some of them take a day to get there to pick up their monthly supplies) and travellers to encourage them to stay and help with the local community. The 2023 Bash was a very good year. We raised the highest funds for Car BOB ever with \$41,546.46 which put us in the notable position of 13th highest fundraiser for the whole Bash of 82 cars. The total raised for the 2023 Variety Bash was \$ 2,033,000. The 2023 Variety Bash started at Port Adelaide, travelled through Barmera, Koomooloo Station, Peterborough, Yunta, Antro Woolshed, Broken Hill, Menindee, Robinvale, Pinnaroo, Karoonda, Mannum and finished at McLaren Vale. Since 2011 Car BOB has raised \$324,885.71. A lot of these funds have been raised in the local Community and there are children in the Yorke Peninsula that have received benefits from the funds that we raise. I appreciate the local community's support for helping me to make a child's life better.




